THE BREWERY

Hard Road Brewing is housed in an airy warehouse within the Bayswater industrial park. The convenient location provides easy access to train lines via nearby Bayswater or Boronia stations and there's plenty of onsite and street parking.

The venue is a large open space that has been renovated by the Hard Road team. Inside you'll find industrial décor and a huge stone bar featuring 20 taps of Hard Road brews and rotating guest taps.

Hosting a function and need a space? We welcome groups and clubs for meetings or casual meetings. The brewery is also available to hire for parties and functions. We provide the space, amazing craft beers and can assist with organising catering.

WEEKDAY EVENING

Weekday evening (Monday – Thursday) package commences at 5:00 PM, concluding no later than 11:00 PM

Weekday evening full venue hire \$5,000.00 (inclusive of bar tab up to \$5,000.00).

WEEKEND AFTERNOONS

Saturday afternoon package commences at 12:00 PM, concluding no later than 3:00 PM.

Saturday afternoon full venue hire \$3,000.00 (inclusive of bar tab up to \$3,000.00).

Sunday afternoon package commences at 1:00 PM, concluding no later than 6:00 PM.

Sunday afternoon full venue hire \$4,000.00 (inclusive of bar tab up to \$4,000.00).

WEEKEND EVENINGS

Weekend evening (Friday & Saturday) package commences at 4:00 PM, concluding no later than 11:00 PM.

Weekend evenings full venue hire \$6,000.00 (inclusive of bar tab up to \$6,000.00).



VENUE HIRE INCLUSIONS

- Exclusive use of the taphouse, its tables, chairs, bar and serviettes
- Gift table
- Welcome blackboard and easel
- Private bridal room
- The greeting of guests
- Liaising with your external vendors to confirm and coordinate set up, pack down and additional requirements.
- Venue capacity is a maximum of 100 guests.

MINORS AND CREW

Minors are welcome to attend the taphouse, but they must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or guardian. Crew attending your function (photographers, MC's or celebrants) will not be counted toward your party number and will not be served without your prior approval.

MUSIC

It's safe to say beer and music go hand in hand. Management of music is important as we are restricted by our close proximity to residential neighbours. If you're planning to include live music at your function it must be acoustic. You must arrange your own DJ, musician or band, and this will need to be approved with Hard Road's management prior to your function.

DEPOSIT

An initial deposit of \$1,500.00 is required to secure your booking date, accompanied by a signed copy of our booking agreement. Please note your booking is not confirmed until payment of the deposit is received and receipted by Hard Road Brewing.

ADDITIONAL PAYMENT

Further to the initial deposit, the rest of your payment is required 4 weeks prior to your function date.



CANCELLATION

In the unfortunate event of a cancellation, Hard Road must receive written notification at least 3 days prior to your nominated booking. With adequate advance notice your initial deposit and payment, less a \$500.00 administration fee, will be refunded.

GUEST CONDUCT

The person who has signed the booking agreement is responsible for the behaviour of guests. That person will be liable for the cost of any damage incurred at the venue or on the grounds of the venue.

Hard Road is privileged to be licensed by the VCGLR to service alcohol to patrons of functions held at the venue. The protection of our license and duty of care to our patrons is important. Hard Road staff reserves the right to immediately conclude the function in the case of alcohol or illicit substance abuse by guests. Pursuant to the provisions of the Occupational Health and Safety Act 2004 (VIC), Hard Road must, so far as is reasonably practical, provide and maintain for its employees a working environment that is safe and without risks to health, including psychological health.

You must ensure that neither you or any member of your party behaves in any manner, including by correspondence, telephone or during the function which poses a threat to health, including psychological health, of any of our employees. This is an essential term of your contract with us. If in our reasonable opinion you breach this term we may end your contract immediately while maintaining our right to damages for breach.
